2/05/09: E-mail from Cathy Quinn, RCDOH: Spill 0803248, also 0712034 Mobil was closing station last summer, removed tanks and submitted a GES report addressed to Jim Hardy 8/8/08. The report asks for spill closure. Should not be closed...notes say the islands were left in place, the site had remed and hydraulic control to prevent offsite movement of known onsite contam; expect widespread contam.; wait til new tank install before close...2 of 3 MW results violate BTEX and MtBE TAGMs in the last samples collected before tanks pulled; 4 post excav samples collected exceed TAGMs for 16 compounds ; on site 6/17/08 RCDOH inspector notes petro odor in excav groundwater 3' below grade. A NEW tenant has come in and is installing tanks, so the ground is opened again. Contractor calls today to say contam present, is faxing a letter documenting same.

11/10/15 – The ORC workplan has been approved. Four ORC injection points will be install in the area of monitoring well MW-5. KAB

12/14/16 – Monitoring well MW-5 still has significant levels of petroleum constituents and occasionally free product. Approval was given to inject MrcroSorb SC (microbes) into monitoring well MW-5. This material was initially approved to be used on a Westchester County spill site with similar conditions. KAB
