UNKNOWN AMOUNT OF OIL SPILLED INTO SOIL FOUND TODAY WHILE UNDER INVESTIGATION. SITE WAS A FORMER OIL TANK OWNED BY STANDARD OIL IN THE 1930'S. WOULD LIKE A CALL BACK.

6/17/09 LINDENFELSER MEETS RICH BILLS & STEVE ORCUTT OF DPW AT SITE BEHIND HOUSES ALONG RT 119 AGAINST THE CANISTEO RIVER; THEY HAVE JIM MANZELLA (SP?) OF TVGA CONSULTANTS (BUFFALO AREA) MONITORING TEST PITTING VIA EXCAVATER AND MICRO WELL INSTALLATION VIA

A TRACK PUSH PROBE BY RUSSO ENVIRONMENTAL; THEY SHOWED THE TWO, NOW BACKFILLED, PITS WHERE THEY HAD GOT 900 PPM YESTERDAY: THEY WERE AT THE SUPPOSED PERIMETER OF ONE OF THE TWO FORMER 350,000 GAL STORAGE TANKS AT THE WEST END OF THE SITE; FURTHER EAST AT ANOTHER BACKFILLED PIT, A COUPLE INCH BLOB OF BLACK, TARRY LOOKING CRUDE OIL SAT ON TOP OF THE GROUND; THEY ARE CONDUCTING A PRELIMINARY SURVEY NOT MEANT TO PRECISELY DELINEATE THE CONTAMINATION WHICH COME LATER; PL ADVISED THAT EXXON-MOBIL HAS IN RECENT YEARS CLEANED UP OTHER SITES THAT HAD BEEN OPERATED BY THE ORIGINAL STANDARD OIL CO DECADES AGO;

SPRING 2014 KEHOE ON SITE WITH RICH BILLS TO OBSERVE SITE AND GET IDEA OF WHERE MONITORING WELLS ARE LOCATED.

05/13/14 1300 KEHOE ON SITE TO CHECK STATUS BEFORE WEEDS GROW. NO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION COULD BE FOUND OR OBSERVED.

03/22/16 1045 KEHOE TELECON WITH RICH BILLS ABOUT DEVELOPING A SGMP.

06/09/16 KEHOE TELECON WITH STEVE ORCUTT ABOUT SGMP. EMAIL TO STEVE WITH SGMP DETAILS. COUNTY PLANS TO PREPARE A PLAN AND ALLOW A FARMER TO USE LAND.

10/26/16 KEHOE TELECON WITH STEVE ORCUTT, COUNTY IS WORKING ON A SGMP IN-HOUSE, NO RUSH ON THERE END, NO BUYER YET BUT CONSIDERING SALE OF PROPERTY.
