GASOLINE CONTAMINATED SOIL ENCOUNTERED DURING WORK ON NATURAL GAS MAIN. SOIL IS BEING STOCKPILED ON PLASTIC.

DEC Investigator Remarks:

12/07/2011: TH TO INSPECT. REPORT E-MAILED TO MONROE COUNTY.

12/07/2011: TH ARRIVES AT SITE AT 1030 HOURS AND MEETS WITH BRENT WOODS/FOREMAN FOR LIBERTY UNDERGROUND. **GASOLINE CONTAMINATED SOIL AND AN ORPHANED 500 GALLON UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK WERE ENCOUNTERED DURING INSTALLATION OF A NEW 6 GAS MAIN** THROUGH THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF MT. HOPE SERVICE PARKING LOT. AS PER PROPERTY OWNER (JEFF SOLOMAN 585-461-3120), THE AREA IN QUESTION IS OWNED BY THE CITY OF ROCHESTER THROUGH EASEMENT/RIGHT-OF-WAY. SOLOMAN ALSO STATES THAT HE HAS NEVER OPERATED/DISPENSED PETRO AT THIS FACILITY. HISTORICAL PHOTOS SHOW THE BUILDING BEING OPERATED AS A MOBIL STATION IN THE PAST. EXXON-MOBIL (DOUG DUGAN 609-306-8281) IS NOTIFIED OF THE UST DISCOVERY AND OF THEIR POTENTIAL RESPONSIBILITY. JANE FORBES (CITY OF ROCHESTER) IS LOOKING INTO HISTORICAL RECORDS ALSO. TO EXPEDITE THE TANK REMOVAL/SOIL REMOVAL AND GAS MAIN INSTALLATION, NATIONAL VACUUM CORPORATION IS RETAINED. THE CONTAMINATED SOIL IS TRANSPORTED TO STAGING AREA AT 1581 MT. HOPE AVENUE AND PLACED ON AND COVERED WITH POLY. ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE MADE TO REMOVE THE TANK ASAP.

12/08/2011: TH ON SITE AT 1000 HOURS. NATIONAL VACUUM HAS VACCED OUT THE 500 GALLON UST. DAVE ENGERT WITH SAW ENVIRONMENTAL IS ON SITE TO MONITOR THE TANK REMOVAL (PERMITTED WITH THE CITY OF ROCHESTER) AND TO TRANSPORT THE TANK TO SAWS' MACEDON FACILITY FOR DECOMMISSIONING/SCRAPING. FIRE MARSHAL (STEVE ERSTENIUK) ON SITE AT 1120 HOURS TO WITNESS REMOVAL. NATIONAL VACUUM VAC TRUCK AND CREW STANDBY WHILE LIBERTY UNDERGROUND COMPLETES TRENCHING THROUGH CONTAMINATED ZONE. SEVERAL LENGTHS OF STEEL PIPING (1 1/4 - 2 DIAMETER) WERE ENCOUNTERED DURING TRENCHING BUT NO OTHER TANKS WERE FOUND. APPROXIMATELY 40 TONS OF GASOLINE CONTAMINATED SOIL WAS REMOVED AND IS STAGED AT 1581 MT. HOPE PENDING DISPOSAL.

01/12/2012: FINAL CAP INVOICE FROM NATIONAL VAC RECEIVED, REVIEWED, AND APPROVED. DISPOSAL DOCUMENTATION FOR LIQUID WASTE AND CONTAMINATED SOIL IS INCLUDED.

01/18/2012: EXXONMOBIL IS NOTIFIED IN WRITING OF THEIR RESPONSIBILITY FOR COSTS INCURRED. EXXONMOBIL IS ALSO DIRECTED TO PERFORM FURTHER WORK TO IDENTIFY THE PRESENCE OF OTHER ORPHAN USTs ON THE PROPERTY. EXXONMOBIL ACCEPTS RESPONSIBILITY ON 03/02/2012.

03/26/2012: FINAL ISR SUBMITTED TO ALBANY. THE SPILL IS BEING KEPT OPEN.
